**IV. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORK**

Restoration of original wooden windows, to include: de-glazing, scraping, repairing damage/rot, priming/painting (oil based), and reglazing (linseed oil glazing putty) with original "wavy glass". Existing storm windows cleaned and replaced.

Some sash components (rails) were re-milled to match original as they were rotted beyond repair.

A few pieces of glass were broken in de-glazing process and were subsequently replaced with remanufactured "wavy" glass to maintain authentic integrity. Finding glass through salvage proved to be difficult because of the size of the pane (28"x36").

Window frames were scraped and repaired and repainted (mostly interior), ropes (cotton), pulleys, sash locks, and lifts were cleaned and replaced to original fitment.

**V. ANTICIPATED PROJECT TIMETABLE/SCHEDULE**

Project is ongoing and work is time-consuming. Three upstairs bedroom windows (7) have been completed. Window restoration will continue as described above as other interior restoration and renovation work is completed.
