HOLLIDAYSBURG SEWER AUTHORITY MEETING BOROUGH COUNCIL CHAMBERS OCTOBER 10, 2022 AT 5PM

The Sewer Authority Meeting was called to order at 5:00pm by Chairman Regis Nale, who presided. The following authority members were present - James Burke, James Fitch, and Carol Gale. Also in attendance were Frank Hicks, Jr., Director of Wastewater Operations; Borough Manager Jim Gehret; Dan Beyer of The EADS Group; and Jessica Oswald, Recording Secretary.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: A motion was made by Ms. Gale to accept the August 8, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fitch. The motion passed unanimously.

Engineer's Report: Mr. Beyer talked about the next opportunity to submit a grant application. The Berwind Road project was discussed for this application.
