HOLLIDAYSBURG SEWER AUTHORITY MEETING BOROUGH COUNCIL CHAMBERS AUGUST 8, 2022 AT 5PM

The Sewer Authority Meeting was called to order at 5:00pm by Chairman Regis Nale, who presided. The following authority members were present - James Burke, James Fitch, and Carol Gale. Also in attendance were Frank Hicks, Jr., Director of Wastewater Operations; Borough Manager Jim Gehret; and Jessica Oswald, Recording Secretary.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: A motion was made by Mr. Burke to accept the July 11, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fitch. The motion passed unanimously.

The motion passed unanimously.
